Pool Rules

1. An adult must accompany all children under the age of 8.
2. Swim suits **only!**
3. If you plan to leave Aageson Pool and come back (same session), please have your hand stamped by the cashier prior to leaving the facility to avoid additional charges.
4. Persons with infections, open sores, or rashes are prohibited from entering the pool. .
5. Hair with a length of six inches or longer must be braided or pulled up.
6. Swim aid devices such as life jackets and water wings will be allowed. Parents **must** be within arms reach of child.
7. NO food, juice or carbonated beverages on deck (drinking water allowed).
8. If a child has more than one time-out in a day, they will be removed from Aageson Pool with a phone call to the parents.
9. Swim diapers required for children not potty-trained.
10. **Swimmers must shower before entering the pool.**
11. All Swimmers must follow the posted pool rules.

Our lifeguards are highly trained and skilled. Their jobs are to assist in making the pool a safe place to bring the family. However, they are not baby-sitters. Parents are expected to watch their children and to assist in enforcing the rules and policies of the pool and the Parks & Recreation Department for the safety and enjoyment of all patrons. In addition, all children under the age of 8 must be accompanied and supervised by an adult. Thank you for your cooperation.
