

Resident or Non-Resident

Residency Requirements:

The City of Oconto declares the following policy for residency requirements:

1. A person is considered a resident if the citizen resides within the corporate boundaries of the City of Oconto (Not school district or postal city).
2. A person is not considered a resident if any of the following occur:
A City of Oconto business owner that lives outside of the City of Oconto limits.

Citizens that reside outside of the City of Oconto limits. If you live in the Town of Little River, Town of Oconto, Town of Pensaukee you are a non-resident.

Baby sitters, day care employees, relatives, and participants that live outside the corporate limits of the City of Oconto.

You Cannot provide proof of residency when registering for programs.

NOTE: Those residents in the Oconto School District will be considered residents for all Park & Rec. programs held at a school district facility.

-Those members of the Oconto Youth Center will be considered residents for all Park & Rec. programs held at the Oconto Youth Center facility.

-Those members of the Bond Community Center will be considered residents for all Park & Rec. programs held at the Bond Community Center facility.
