Teen Advisory Position

- The teen advisory seats on the Park Board shall be open to persons of high school age who reside in the City of Oconto.
- The term of the appointment shall be for one year and shall run from July 1 through June 30.
- All regular appointments shall be made by June 1 of each year by the Mayor of Oconto. A special appointment may be made to finish the unexpired term for a seat vacated during the term.
- Applications shall be on a form supplied by the Director and shall be submitted to the Director on or before May 1 of each year. The Director shall review all submissions and may interview those persons whom the Director deems qualified and shall make recommendation to the Mayor of Oconto on whom to appoint to the teen advisory seats.
- The Board of Park & Rec. Commissioners holds a regular scheduled meeting on the first Wednesday of the month and starts at 5:15 pm.
- An agenda and packet of support information is sent to all board members prior to the meeting. Board members are expected to view the material prior to the meeting.
- The Teen Advisory Position is a participating member of the committee, however does not have a legal vote.
- Each Teen Board member is attempted to be paired with a current board member to serve as a guide or mentor.

- Attend meetings with regular consistency.
