Holiday, Reservation & Wood Policies

Holiday Policy

- All weekends are considered non-holiday weekends except for Memorial Day, 4th of July and Labor Day Weekends. Where as for these Holiday dates, reservations must be reserved for a minimum of three nights. The amount of deposit for a holiday weekend is the rate of two nights.

Reservation Policy

- We accept reservations one year in advance for the up coming season (May 1-Oct. 31). After Labor Day, reservations are not needed (unless for a large group). However, after October 31st you are unable to make reservations until the first business day of the New Year.
- All reservations require a credit card or advance deposit. Credit cards will not be charged unless there is a breach of reservation policy. The amount of deposit for non-holiday weekends is the rate of one night.
- If a cancellation or arrival date change is made less than 7 days prior to the arrival date, the full amount of the deposit is non-refundable. If you are holding a site under a credit card number, there will be a \$5.00 service charge per site. We do not issue refunds due to weather conditions.

Wood Policy

All wood brought into Holtwood Campground & City Park Campground must be:

- Firewood purchased within 50 mile radius of that property.
- AND harvested in Wisconsin.
- AND NOT purchased, harvested or stored in, or transported through a quarantined county of Wisconsin. **These include: Ozaukee, Washington, Fond du Lac, Brown, Waukesha, Milwaukee, Racine, Kenosha, Crawford, Vernon and Sheboygan Counties.** (Due to the Emerald Ash Borer, a insect that is killing Ash Trees)
- Firewood from a vendor that is certified by the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture.
- Dimensional and untreated lumber scraps, such as 2-by-4s and 2-by-6s.

If you are a camper from outside of Wisconsin, please do not bring firewood with you. It will be confiscated and if the wood is from a quarantined area, you could be violating a federal law that forbids moving wood of any kind out of your state or county of residence. Be aware, if you transport firewood from Illinois, Indiana, Ohio, or lower Michigan, you can be liable for federal fines up to \$1,000.00. If you are a camper from Wisconsin, please do not bring firewood that has been stored, purchased, harvested, or moved through (with stops longer than necessary to re-fuel your vehicle) Ozaukee, Washington, Fond du Lac, Brown, Waukesha, Milwaukee, Racine, Kenosha, Crawford, Vernon and Sheboygan Counties.

Counties to properties outside of those counties. It will be confiscated and you would be violating state law. If you are bringing firewood from elsewhere in Wisconsin, please only use firewood from a Wisconsin source within 50 miles of where you will use it. Ideally, purchase firewood from within the campground where you are staying, as that wood is often cut on site and sold by groups who reinvest earnings in the same park. If you purchase your firewood outside of the park but within a non-quarantined area of Wisconsin, near the campground you are visiting, please have a receipt ready to show proof of that purchase.
